**Notice of Market Dominance Determination
Identification of Relevant Product Markets and the
Determination of Dominance Amongst Licensed Operators
in the Electronic Communications Industry**

IN ACCORDANCE with Section 40 of the Information and Communication Technologies Act, No. 15 of 2009

This Notice confirms the determination by the Zambia Information and Communications Technology Authority (Authority) that certain holders of licences issued by the Authority are holding a dominant position in identified relevant electronic communications markets.

The determination was made in accordance with—

- (a) competition procedures and principles for identifying relevant product markets in the electronic communications industry in Zambia;
- (b) share of supply threshold for establishing the existence of a dominant position as set out in the Competition Guidelines of 2021 issued by the Authority pursuant to the ICT Act; and
- (c) Section 15 of the Competition and Consumer Protection Act No. 24 of 2010.

By this publication, the Authority hereby gives notice of the determination of the following licensees as holding a dominant position in the respective relevant markets in the electronic communications industry shown below:

The circumstances and analysis supporting the determination of dominance in the relevant markets are based on international best practices of assessing the levels of competition in a market.

This determination shall be valid from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.

All terms and expressions used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the ICT Act, Competition and Consumer protection Act and Competition guidelines.
